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# GENERAL INFORMATION

Mexican law now requires that the primary guest submits a photocopy of their passport, profession and home address. This will need to be provided at the time of booking.

## Arrival information

Our check-in time is 4pm and check-out time is 11am Central Standard Time.

If you have pre-arranged transfer service with us from the airport to the villa, a driver will be at the airport waiting for you. After passing through immigration, clearing customs and the vacation resort time-share sales area, you will pass through two sliding doors (still inside the airport just before the street). That is where the driver will be waiting for you holding a sign with your last name.

Local regulations do not allow us to pick guests up at the airport so if you request airport to villa transportation we will utilize licensed transportation companies such as VIP PV Transport, VIP Class tours and Superior Tours: Costs start at \$135 USD one way and 260 USD round trip. It is approximately 50 minutes from the airport to the villa.

If you choose to rent your own vehicle exit the airport and follow the signs for "Tepic / Guadalajara" which will take you beneath an overpass, bearing to the left like a U-turn. You will be heading north on the "Carretera 200". Continue on this main road north, past several small villages of Las Juntas, Mezcales and Bucerías.

After driving approximately 12 miles you will leave the village Bucerías. Driving up a hill, you see three signs with "Tepic, Punta de Mita & Puerto Bahia". At the next sign with "MARINA Riviera Nayarit" you turn right; this turnoff on the right hand side will take you on an overpass above the main road, heading west.

Keep driving on this road another 15 miles, and after a long straight you see a sign "Iberostar" and "Playa Mita". Crossing the intersection, you will see the first Punta Mita entrance at your right. The gate agent will give you further directions for Majani within Punta Mita. Our "Majani" sign within bougainvillea bushes is very discreet at "La Punta".

## Local Telephone Calls

Local telephone number is 298 7300 as dialed within Bahia de Banderas in the state of Nayarit. If making a call from the villa, you dial "9" to get an outside line. At the end of this handbook you will find important local telephone numbers.

Area codes are 322 for Puerto Vallarta, Jalisco and 329 for Bahia de Banderas, Nayarit. All mobile numbers start with 322 and you add 045 in front of the 10 digits (3 digit area code and 7 digit number). For local hard line numbers you dial only the 7 digits. Puerto Vallarta numbers are considered long distance, so they require an additional 01 plus the area code.

Casa Majani is equipped with two Mexican DSL lines for Internet service. If you choose to bring your smartphone, tablet or laptop there is Wi-Fi in most areas within the villa.

## Sound

Feel free to bring your own device, as we have a SONOS music system in each room as well as the outdoor pool & palapa area.

Simply install the free SONOS App on your mobile device and connect to our WiFi to listen to your music, our library, or streaming online music.

## Pool

The temperature of both pools can be adjusted according to your liking. Please let us know if you would like the temperature lower than the standard 80 degrees.

When using the pool, please use the towels found at the pool area rather than the towels located inside the rooms. For your safety, we ask you to use only plastic cups and plates near the pool.

## Air Conditioning

We set your room temperature at 74 degrees Fahrenheit. Please let us know if you prefer a different setting.

## Water

Casa Majani has a state-of-the-art water filtration system. Water from the tap is perfectly safe to drink and brush your teeth.

## Dining service

We recommend our complete Meal Plan, \$100 USD per adult (age 12+) per day including all food and non-alcoholic beverages. Children 3 to 11 years of age are \$50 per day. Meals include breakfast, a three-course lunch and a four-course dinner. The three meals are prepared daily during your stay between 8am and 9pm.

The same meal plan including house wine and alcohol \$150 USD per person per day. 16% VAT included with all meal plans. A premium wine list is available with discount prices for guests on the \$150 USD per day meal plan.

Please wire transfer a food, beverage and activities deposit prior to your arrival to our US account.

Guillermo will provide an Expense report at the end of your stay for all beverage purchases on your behalf outside of our meal plan and if it applies, requested activities. If there is a surplus, it will be returned to you by your choice of check or wire transfer. Should additional funds be needed, we will let you know. Please note that all in-villa expenses in excess of your US deposit (premium alcohol, staff gratuity, etcetera) must be paid in cash, as there are no credit card facilities at the villa.

For over 12 guests (14 with children) for any meal, please ask for our Policy for Events and Entertaining.

### ATM's

There are a few ATM machines in Punta de Mita. Typically, banks allow daily withdrawals of \$3,000 to \$5,000 MX Pesos. This amount is roughly equivalent to \$200 - \$300 USD per day. Your total expenses, which might include but are not limited to airport transfers, food & beverages purchases, yoga instructors, massages, staff tipping and other miscellaneous expenses, must be settled prior to departure.

### Tipping

Tipping of the household employees is strictly voluntary. The amount of the tips would, of course, depend on your perception of the service. Your discretionary gratuity will be divided even between all the staff members.

Most guests find it is best to give the entire tip to the Manager to distribute. This way, some of the people who make your stay pleasant, but whom you seldom see, such as the gardeners and the engineer are not forgotten. The suggested basic level of tipping is \$50 per bedroom, per night.

### Medical assistance

Punta Mita Hospital has a new 13,000 square foot medical facility.

The Emergency Room accepts patients 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The ER has three emergency and monitoring beds, one pediatric cubicle with two observation and monitoring beds, a shock room for critical patients, X-ray, full lab and physician working 24/7, as well as ambulance service.
